**Applications will be accepted during the period of January 1 – April 1, 2018.**

We are a high volume academic Echo Lab and the 1<sup>st</sup> to be accredited by the CCN in Ontario. Our imaging research programs are supported by HSF, CFI, SEAMO.

Echo Fellows training in our lab will have the opportunity to become experts in performing and interpreting TEE, TTE, as well as develop skills in 3D Echo, Strain, CRT Optimization, contrast and guidance of interventional procedures (TAVI).

We conduct >1000 DSE, TSE, BSE tests a year

There are POCUS and vascular imaging projects available. Candidates are exposed to CT and Nuclear training and have the opportunity to gain experience in Animal Imaging. Research is highly promoted.

This fellowship offers a one-year salaried position.

There are 4 weeks of cardiology clinical/ward obligations.
